Accident Reporting

Introduction:

To be able to carry out accident investigation, to identify root and multiple causes, and be able to make recommendations to prevent recurrence. To understand legal reporting requirements under RIDDOR 1995.

Aims

- Report to senior management on the implications of an accident.
- Preserve the scene of an accident
- Make management aware of the requirements to prevent similar situations arising again.
